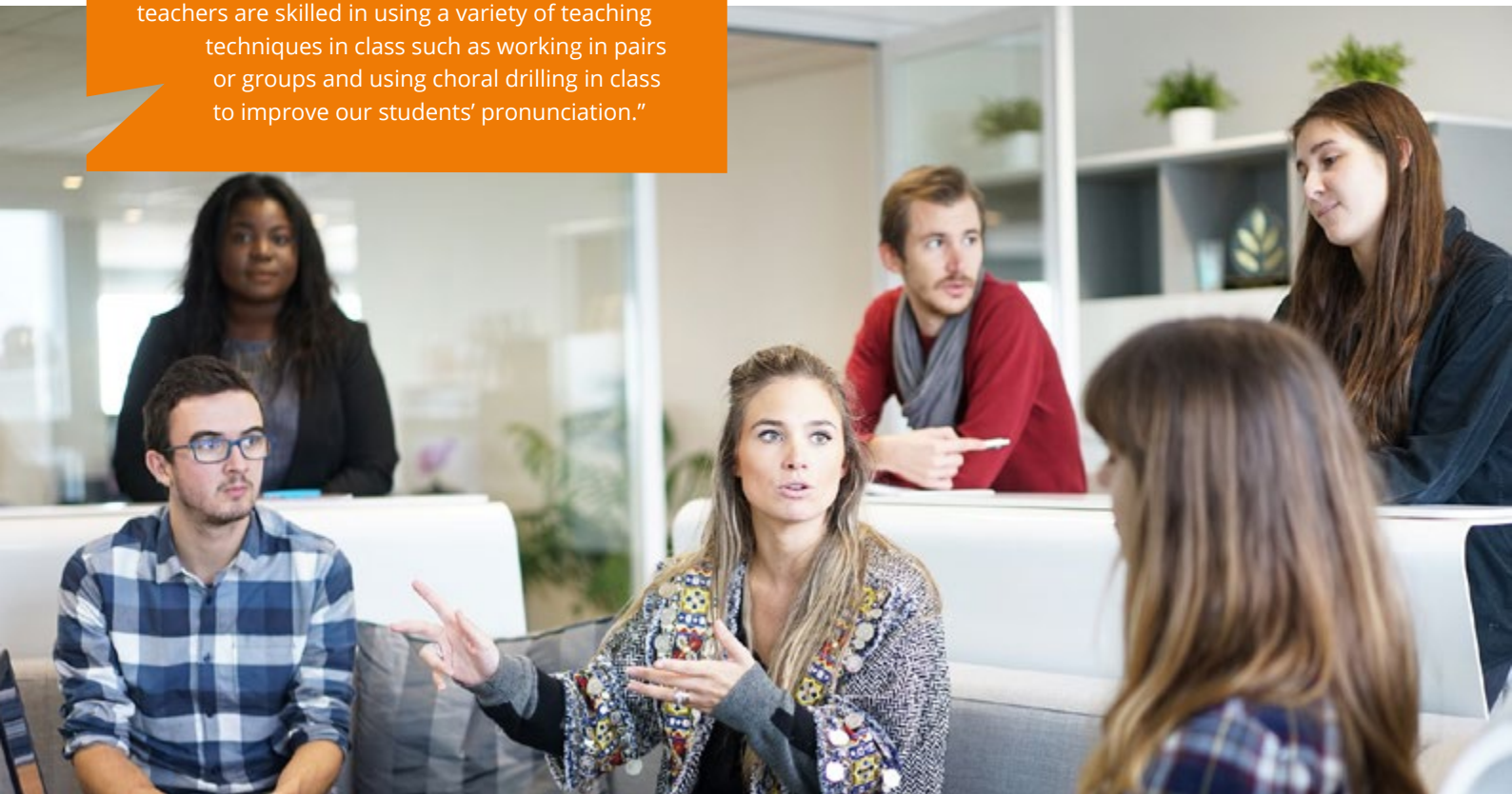

Electives

At The English Studio we offer Elective sessions to help students achieve their personal goals. Electives have been designed to improve students' confidence and ability in a social and professional setting.

For 2022, our schools will offer the following electives to students on General, Intensive, Exam English and English for Business courses:

LONDON AND OXFORD



Speaking

Our speaking classes aim to improve fluency of English and speed of delivery. Learning how to manage conversations, students will gain confidence to speak in a variety of formal and informal situations.

Project-Based English

The Project-Based English classes help students to develop a broad range of skills in English. These may include making a short film or radio programme, writing for a blog or school magazine, or organising a social programme.

Writing

Our writing elective will help students improve their effective and appropriate use of language in writing. Through practice, students will become more assured when writing in different formats and contexts.

Professional English

Ideal for those students who want to make improving their English for working in an international environment a priority during their course.

DUBLIN



Conversation

Our conversation classes will increase confidence and teach students how to manage conversations, as they practise speaking in a variety of formal and informal situations with their teacher and classmates.

IELTS Preparation (new for 2022)

The IELTS elective is a great option for students on our General English course who may wish to take the IELTS exam in the future and would like an introduction into the skills needed to succeed in the exam.

OET Preparation (new for 2022)

Designed specifically for healthcare professionals that would like to register to work and practise in an English-speaking environment, the OET elective will help prepare students to take the Occupational English Test.

Students will study a range of medical language and appropriate ways of communicating effectively with patients and their families.

The electives offered may be dependent on the term and individual student's English level.

General English

General English is always our most popular English course and is available for every level from complete beginner through to advanced.

And with our General English 20 option, students benefit from an additional 5 hours each week in our elective classes to further improve their fluency.

The courses are suitable for students at any level. Students are placed in the correct class based on their placement test and regular progression testing.

Our teaching methods aim to develop communication skills, with an emphasis on speaking, pronunciation, grammar and listening. This approach is further reinforced in our 20-hour course where students can enjoy one of our elective options.

ONE-TO-ONE TUITION

One-to-one English lessons provide students with the individual attention they need to learn at their own pace, in their own way and at a time that they choose. Whether students are looking to improve in one specific area of English, work on their pronunciation or prepare for an interview or exam, our teachers can help them with their individual learning needs.

Intensive English (London and Oxford)

Our Intensive English courses help students to communicate easily and confidently in English. Whether students are complete beginners, intermediate or even advanced, with either 25 or 30 hours of tuition per week, this is the recommended option to help them learn English more quickly.

Designed with our students' progress in mind, they will learn at the right level for their ability, with teacher support and regular progression testing throughout the course.

Students practise authentic English in a variety of ways including group work, pair work and individual work. Ideal for students whose time to study is limited or simply wanting to improve their English quickly.

On the Intensive English course, alongside General English language classes, students will study a selection of our elective classes dependent on their learning goals and English level.

The Intensive English courses are accredited by the British Council.

Exam English

At The English Studio we are proud to have successfully prepared many students for English language exams over the years. We recommended our exam preparation courses for students planning to take a specific English language exam.

These courses are designed to prepare students to take an internationally recognised exam that they will need to enter their chosen college or university, or to work as a healthcare professional in an English-speaking environment.

CAMBRIDGE IELTS EXAM PREPARATION

The IELTS Exam Preparation course is one of our most popular options. Our teachers have helped many students achieve the IELTS score they needed. In recent years taking the IELTS exam has become one of the most popular methods to gain access to UK and Irish university courses for second language speakers. Our course helps students develop the academic reading and writing skills, and confidence, for university life — and beyond!

CAMBRIDGE C1 ADVANCED EXAM

The C1 Advanced, or CAE, exam is accepted by more than 9,000 educational institutions and businesses as evidence of high-level achievement in learning English. This course is structured around monitoring and assessing our students' progress until they are sufficiently prepared to take the exam.

OET EXAM PREPARATION

New for 2022, the OET Preparation course is designed to help students build the skills required for success in the Occupational English Test. The test assesses the student's understanding of English in a workplace-related healthcare context and is recognised by the Nursing and Midwifery Council (NMC) and the General Medical Council (GMC) in the UK and the Medical Council (MC) in Ireland.

STUDENT RESIDENCES

By far the most popular choice for all our adult students, our Student Residences are a good option for those who like a little more independence.

Students share a large house with others from the school in a central location. They have the freedom to discover not only the English language but the city and culture, local community and night-life.

Our Student Residences offer communal areas where students may find themselves cooking cuisines from all over the world, talking about some of their fantastic experiences in the city or making plans for weekend trips away.

With no extra bills, WiFi and bed linen included as well as cleaning of communal areas; this is the smart option for many students.

HOMESTAYS

Living with a host family is a great way for students to practise their English. All our hosts speak English as a first or second language, so students can apply what they learn in English lessons by talking to their host family.

Hosts are recruited, trained and supported by our accommodation partners to make sure high standards of care are given to each and every student. The English Studio's team is also available to offer support to students during their stay.

Students can choose the combination of services to best fit their needs – we offer self-catering, bed and breakfast and half-board meal plans and either single or twin rooms.

STUDIOS

We provide access to high standard Studio accommodation that is purpose-built for students, which offer a great place to study and make friends.

Students have access to communal areas with comfortable furniture and televisions, as well as quieter spaces to study or read. Each Studio room is equipped with a bed, storage, an en-suite shower room and toilet, and either a kitchenette or access to a shared kitchen.

LONDON, DUBLIN AND OXFORD

The English Studio has helped place many of our students with host families throughout London, Dublin and Oxford.

The group of host families we work with reflect the rich culture, ethnicity and diversity of these great cities.

Homestay is the perfect option for students looking for an experience like home during their studies, with lots of opportunities to practise their English with the host family or learn more about the city from the locals.

NEIGHBOURHOOD & TRANSPORT

For students in London, Homestay accommodation can be booked by transport zone, with options ranging from Zone 2 to Zone 5.

They will have easy access to the school on the city's transport network by underground, train or bus.

In Dublin, many of our host families live outside the city centre in houses with gardens in the suburbs.

Students can travel to school on public transport (bus, tram or train) with an average journey time of approximately 40 minutes, though this may be longer at peak traffic times.

ROOMING AND BOARD OPTIONS

Homestay accommodation in London offers flexibility as students can choose either a single room or twin, if booking together with another student on the same type of course (adult or junior).

They also have the options for their meal choice of self-catering, half-board (breakfast included) or full-board (breakfast and evening meal included).

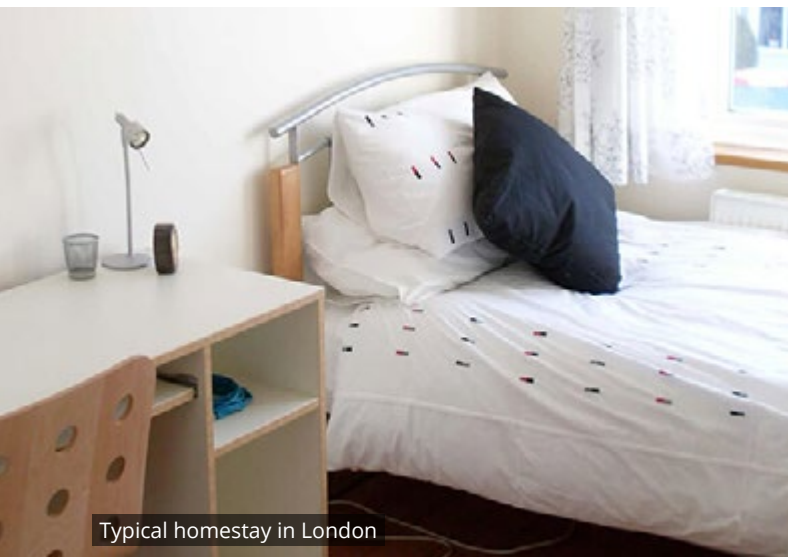

For students in Dublin, all Homestay accommodation comes with half-board included, providing breakfast every morning and a varied evening meal plan.

They can choose from a single room, or for those travelling together twin or double rooms.

Oxford homestay accommodation is situated within 30-55 minutes of the city with good transport links. Options for bed and breakfast, half-board (breakfast and evening meal) or full-board (breakfast, evening meal and packed lunch included) are available.

A superior homestay with dedicated bathrooms for students can be provided on request.

Studio Accommodation

THE STAY CLUB WILLESDEN, LONDON

This studio accommodation from The Stay Club is situated in West London just a few minutes' walk from Willesden Junction station, which is 25 minutes from central London. Our school is 40 minutes from the accommodation on public transport.

Private rooms are fully equipped with a double bed, study space, a kitchenette, en-suite wet room and plenty of storage.

Students have access to a shared lounge area, as well as an on-site cafe.

The residence is monitored by CCTV 24 hours a day along with security staff. Service and housekeeping staff are also on hand to maintain the accommodation.

Other shared facilities include a laundry, bike storage and additional study areas and classrooms.

ARDCAIRN HOUSE, DUBLIN

Ardcairn House is located just a few minutes' from Smithfield and a 5-minute walk from the new Grangegorman Luas Stop. The studio accommodation offers easy access to local amenities, and is just 20 minutes from our school in Dublin!

All the rooms are purpose-built for students, so they can focus on their studies in surroundings designed for just that. And each has its own modern en-suite bathroom with a toilet, sink and large shower cubicle.

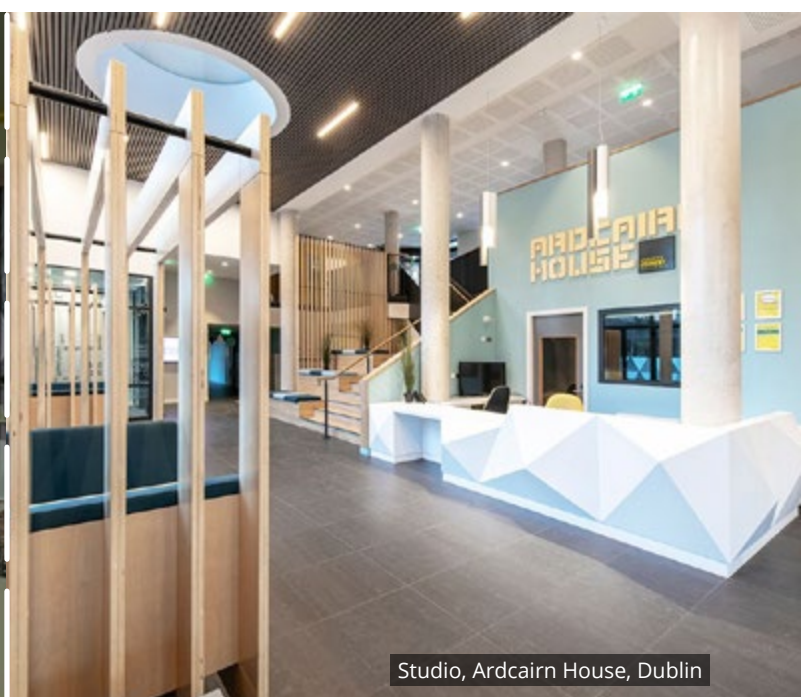
Students have access to a cinema room, a bowling alley, an on-site gym, plenty of common study areas and outdoor areas.

Student Experience

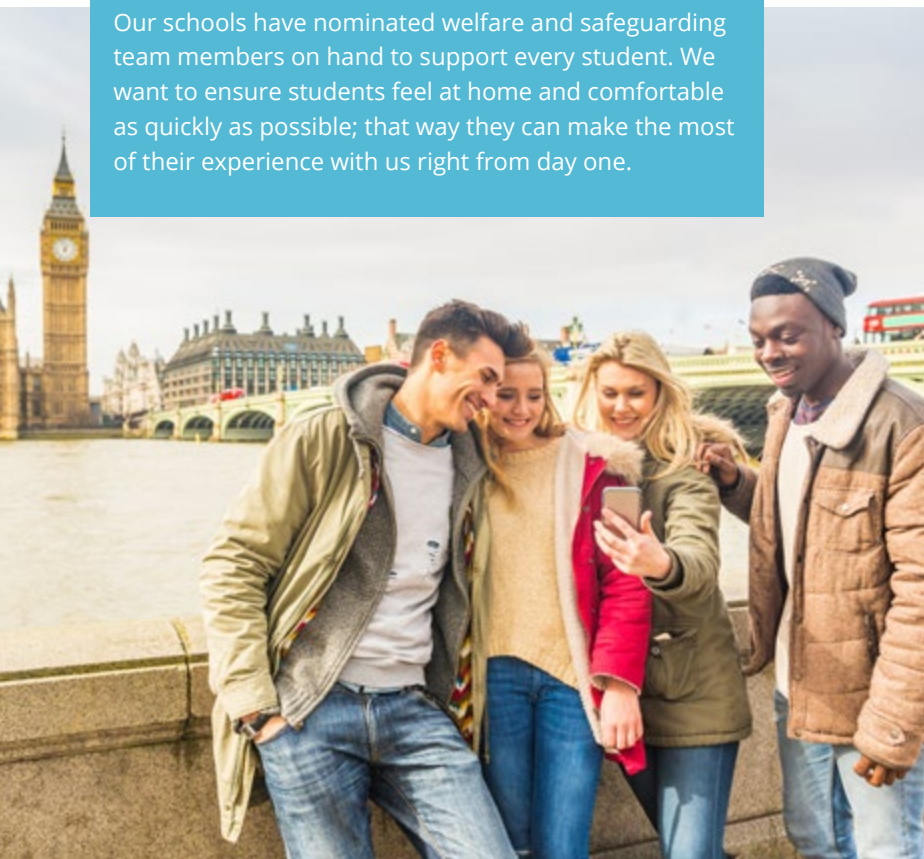
At The English Studio, our focus on the culture, experience and student progress helps us to support and encourage students to feel part of our family and enjoy the best these incredible cities have to offer.

STUDENT WELFARE

STUDENT CLUBS

All students enrolled on a full-time course for adults and 18 years old or over are invited to join our free student clubs. They are a great way for students to supplement learning in class with practical skills needed in the real world and to build their confidence. Clubs are weekly, run for 1 hour and are included in course fees.

Pronunciation Workshop – specific practice to fine-tune speaking, listening and conversation skills.

Current Affairs Conversation Club – we discuss the news, politics and economic viewpoints as students learn useful, everyday vocabulary and build confidence in discussing current affairs in English.

Interview Techniques and CV Writing Skills – ideal for students who want to impress recruiters and secure a job locally or in a global organisation.

Grammar Drop-in Workshop (Dublin only) – a little extra help outside of class focused on grammar. Designed to support students develop areas in which they are struggling and to ensure full understanding.

YES General and Intensive English (London only)

YES GENERAL ENGLISH

Suitable for learners from beginner to advanced levels, our YES General English course, with 15 hours tuition a week, gives students the opportunity to improve their English, practising in a multinational class what they may not learn at school in their home country.

For students aged 8 to 17, the course helps develop each child's communication skills, with an emphasis on speaking, pronunciation and listening.

All students take an English level test before arriving so that they can enjoy their classes from day one by being placed according to their age and ability. During lessons, students get practice using relevant English that's useful outside the classroom, and at the end of the course they will receive a YES Certificate and an End of Course Report to show their parents and teachers back home.

YES INTENSIVE ENGLISH

Combined with General English classes, students have one hour each day dedicated to practising conversation and pronunciation with their teacher and classmates. The YES Intensive English course in London is for students aged 8 to 17.

Our young students develop their fluency in conversational English and receive feedback and correction within class.

During this one-hour elective class the students learn English which they can directly put into practice outside the classroom.

A favourite option for our young students, the YES English & Activities course combines all the benefits of General English classes with a 5-day activity programme to discover the sights and culture of London.

Each day students attend 3 hours of English classes, and following lunch, get to practise what they've learnt in the classroom during the afternoons with activities and excursions.

Activities are planned for students to discover and explore London with children of a similar age and interests.

Our friendly YES Activity Leaders are always there to take care of our young students as well as to make sure they have fun and learn about the city. A hot lunch is provided each day offering 3 or 4 healthy meal options, one of which is vegetarian.

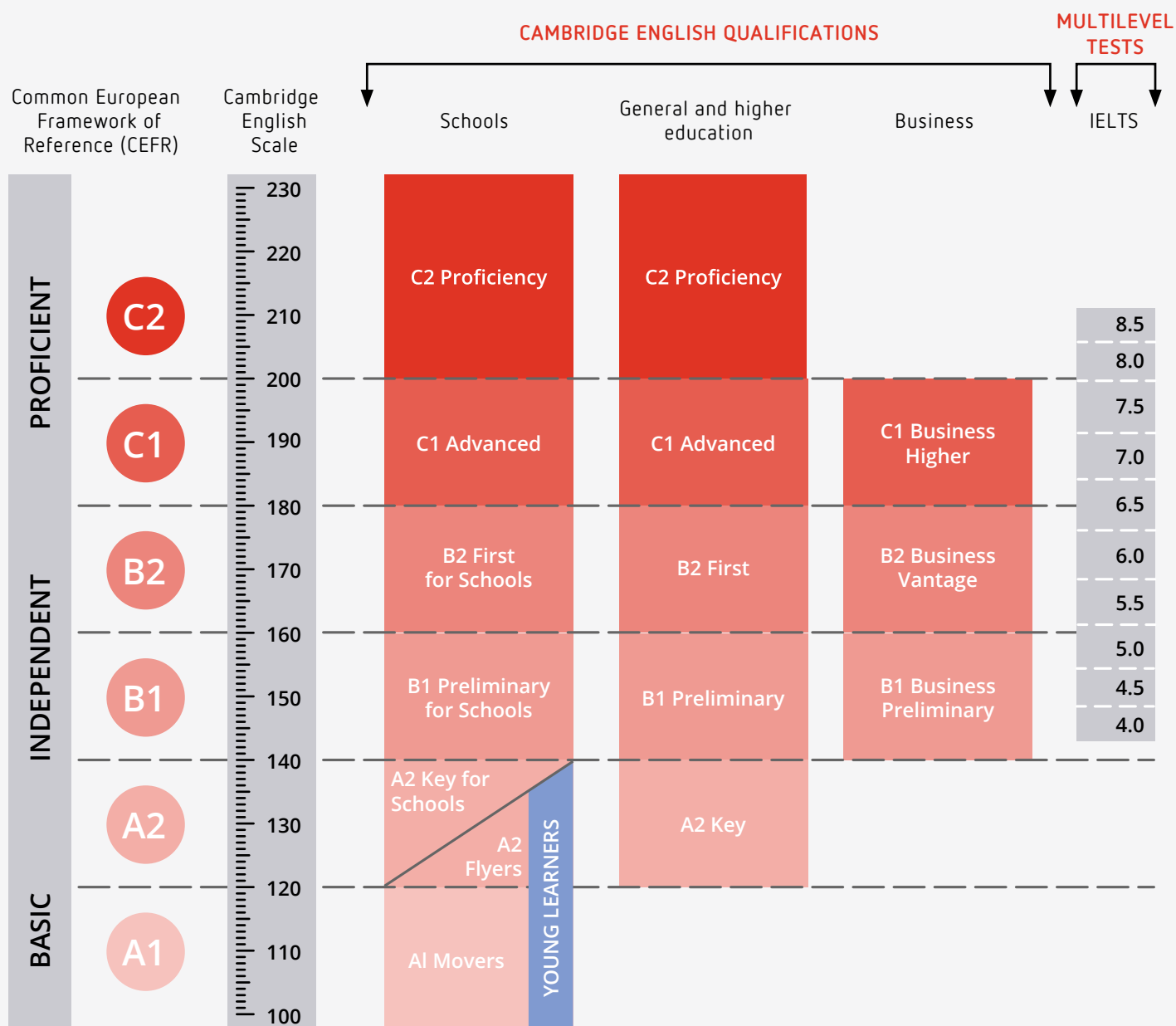
