We aim to ensure all our young learners have a great time and make new friends from other countries. They will learn the language in the classroom and continue learning and

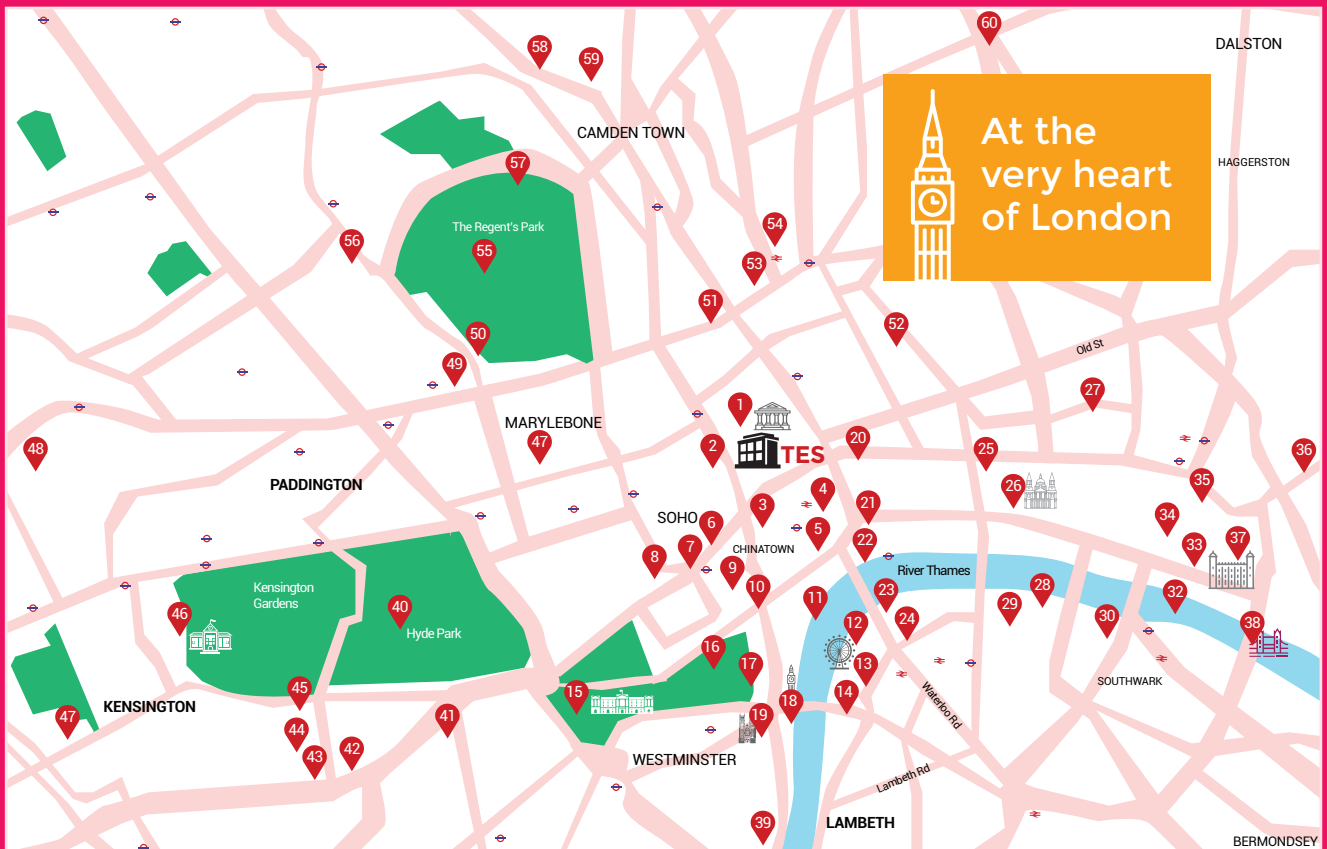
using English during our varied and exciting activity programme. Allow us to help your child grow with a complete well-balanced course and wonderful life experience.

change for our students; that's why we're here to help our learners with everything they may need to settle in.

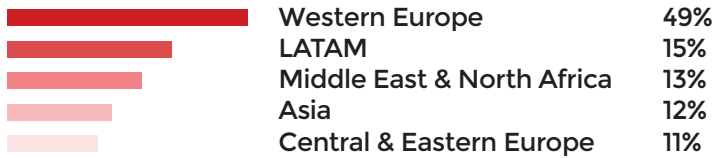
SOCIAL PROGRAMMES AND EXCURSIONS

Suitable for learners from beginner to advanced levels, our YES General English course, with 15 hours tuition a week, gives students the opportunity to improve their English, practising in a multinational class what they may not learn at school in their home country.

The course helps develop each child's communication skills, with an emphasis on speaking, pronunciation and listening. All students take an English level test before arriving so that they can enjoy their classes from day one by being placed according to their age and ability. During lessons, students get practice using relevant English that's useful outside the classroom, and at the end of the course they will receive a YES Certificate and an End of Course Report to show their parents and teachers back home.
